Building the Bridge: Between Two Departments

- Example: MSS 0098 Project
 - Significant single-item (or very small) Delaware collections
 - Minimal Description from Accession Records ingested into ArchivesSpace
 - Created EAD & MARC
 - Students digitized materials
 - Negotiation between MAD & CDC over crosswalk from EAD to UDSpace fields (Dublin Core-based)
 - Creation of input form so students will be able to create records
 - Links will be added to digital collections in ArchivesSpace, so spawned resources will link directly to digital objects
